EAC INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

DEADLINE JULY 25, 2007

The EAC shall provide Show Management with a **Certificate of Liability Insurance** as evidence of coverage on the amounts indicated below.

An Exhibitor Appointed Contracted (EAC) is any individual or company hired to set up and dismantle or provide service to your booth that is not an employee of your company. EAC's include, but are not limited to; Installation and Dismantle Contractors, Booth Designers and Builders, Furniture Suppliers, Piano Movers and Labourers.

Workers' Compensation & Employers Liability:

Workers' Compensation in accordance with the Laws of the Province of Ontario.

Employers Liability: \$500,000 Bodily Injury By Accident – Each Accident
 \$100,000 Property Damage – Combined Single Limits of Both

General Liability: \$2,000,000 General Aggregate
 \$1,000,000 Products & Complete Operations Aggregate
 \$1,000,000 Personal & Advertising Injury
 \$1,000,000 Each Occurrence

The following entries must be named to the General Liability as Additional Insured on the Exhibitor Appointed Contractor's "Comprehensive General Liability Insurance" Policy.

1. MIAC
2. The Toronto International Centre
3. GES Canada

The Exhibitor Appointed Contractor shall furnish MIAC with an original insurance certificate to evidence the insurance coverage required herein. An original signed certificate will only be accepted if received in a PDF format or a fax accompanied by the carrier's letterhead coversheet or mail to MIAC Office.

Coverage must be provided for all Show Days as well as Move-in and Move-out days, August 24 – 28, 2007.

Automobile Liability: \$1,000,000..... Combined Single Limit for Bodily Injury and Property Damage

Show Management must be notified 30 days in advance of any change or cancellation of the above listed policies. In addition, these insurance requirements shall not limit the amount a contractor or insurance company may be found responsible for.

All Certificates of Insurance received are subject to approval by MIAC prior to the performance of any set up and / or disassembly service by any Exhibitor Appointed Contractor.

NOTE: If you are providing services to more than one exhibiting company at the MIAC Show & PAL Showcase, you need only to forward one (1) original Certificate of Liability Insurance.
